BLANDINSVILLE-HIRE LIBRARY – Book Review by Mary Killip –THE TOBACCO WIVES by Adele Myers – This was a fictional account of the lives of wealthy tobacco families and the tobacco industry in a factionalized city in North Carolina at the end of World War II. The circumstances of the story are based on true events and facts. It tells of the elaborate parties and balls hosted by the elite members of that society. The book outlines the dangers of tobacco – harvesting, manufacturing, smoking, and the environment in general – how the facts of the dangers associated with tobacco were hidden and glamorized. It is a story of how women worked in the tobacco factories in unsafe conditions with low pay and then expected to go back to being housewives when the men came home from the war. I highly recommend this book.

History of Blandinsville First Christian Church – Submitted by Jean Dougherty, Church Historian. The year 2024 marks the 175th anniversary of the founding of the Blandinsville First Christian Church in 1849. The following is an excerpt from a board meeting on May 12,1924. "A called meeting of the church was held May 12, 1924, with the following members present: Bros. M. Herzog, A. G. Cox, M. White, N. Wilson, J. Mizner, J. Atwater, M. Burr, Geo. Daniels, F. Leonard, R. L. Cutter, Bruce Bailey, H. Curry, J. Whitaker, J. A. Beeley. Meeting called to order by the president of the board Bro. Herzog. Motion made by Bro. Atwater and seconded by Bro. Cutler that the \$50.00 bond held by the Sunday School and with consent of the Sunday School be sold and the proceeds be applied on the finance fund. Motion carried. There being no other business the meeting adjourned. Signed Marion Herzog, Chairman; J. A. Beeley, Clerk."
